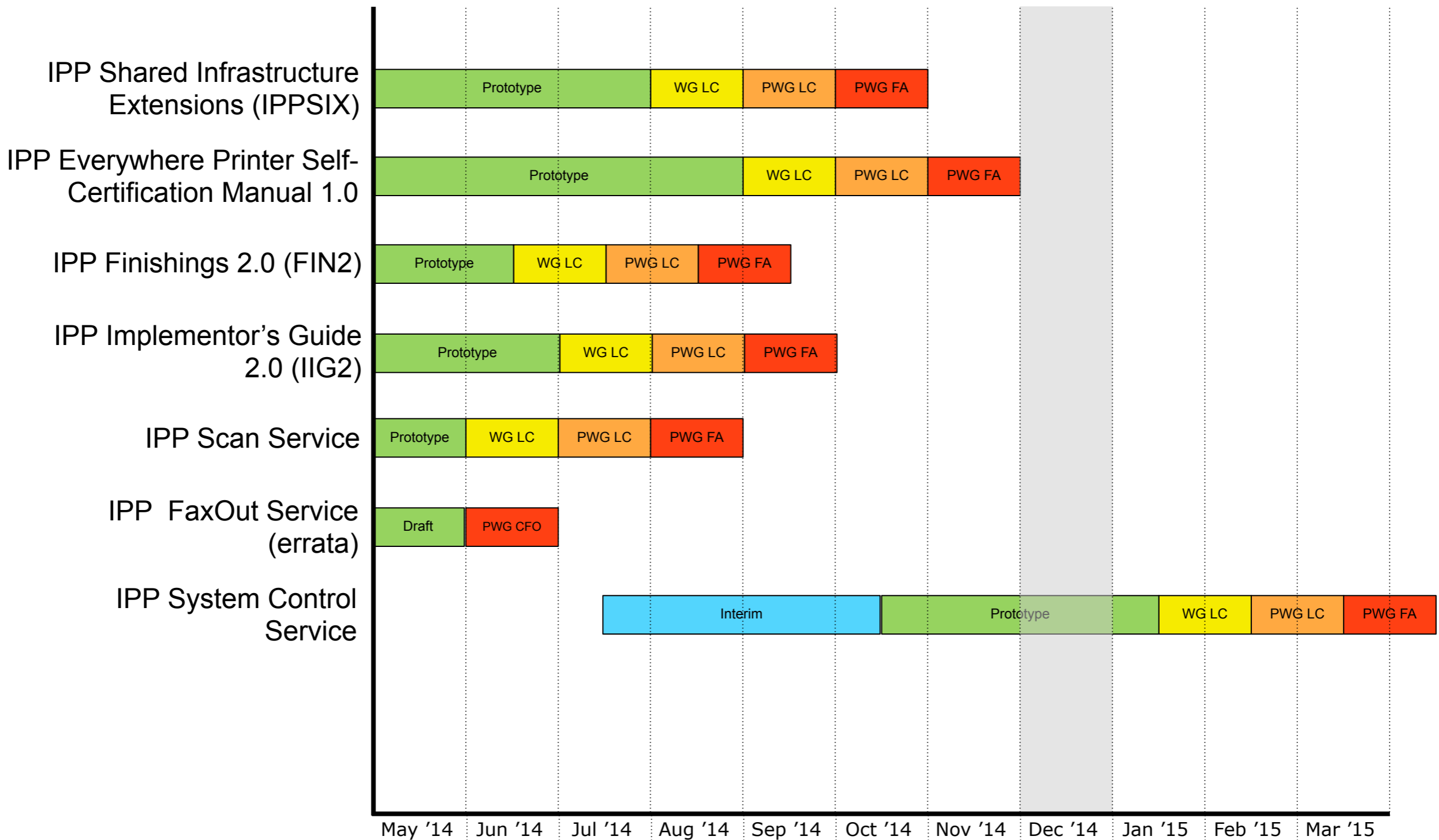
IPP WG Next Steps
