63 <PZ>Job counters have a scope of a single job. Service counters have a scope of all the jobs processed by the service. At this time all service/job related counters share a common data type. The recent change to accommodate persistence had a side effect I missed. The resolution is either to redefine the job level counters or to mandate a lifetime value for the persistence. I prefer the former resolution. Another side effect is that Job counters have counts only applicable to a service (i.e., Availability, Monitoring). I believe the data types for the Job/Document counters needs to be corrected. It should be discussed next week at the MFD meeting.</PZ>

- “Persistence” attribute for any CounterEntry should be eliminated. All counters including System, Subunit, Service, Job, Document counters should be lifetime counters only. The recent change to include “Persistence” was to follow the PWG Counter spec, though Counter spec only requires “lifetime” counters, and allows other persistence. If a vendor is interested in adding other persistence counters, vendor’s extension point can be added.
