 - a. Fix set operations, rearrangement of subunits, FaxLogUri, etc.
 - b. Maintain errata/updates to document
 - c. Publish updated document as SM 2.0 upon completion of enough services
6. FaxIn Service

 - b. Update copyright years in footers and title page
 - c. Section 3.2: Check that "Group Element" is properly deleted.
 - d. Section 4.2: Bullets - update since FaxIn-To-Print etc. are supported.
 - e. Section 6: at end clarify multi-document jobs do not apply to PSTN fax
 - f. All elements tables: verify the list of elements match the schema pictures, check if we need to bold/

- italic elements based on conformance requirements
- g. Section 6.6: Add FaxLogUri element (also check model document/schema)
 - h. Section 7: Around lines 481-483 mention FaxLogUri as the location of the durable log
 - i. Who is the owner of a FaxIn job? The FaxIn ServiceName is the owner of the job (JobOriginatingUserName)
 - No issues with this since "system" or "admin" accounts can create jobs, too, and we also need to be able to store documents (securely) anyways...
 - JobOriginatingUserUri is listening URI (phone number or email address)
 - j. Metrics can be used to tie an owner (e.g. route the job, set the recipient, etc.) based on the incoming phone number, etc.
 - k. Figure 9: FaxInDocument should be 0,1, not unbounded
 - l. Schema: Add JobSenderUri to FaxInMetrics and FaxInJobStatus:FaxInJobDescription
 - Empty string if the phone number/email is unknown.
 - m. Make JobOriginatingUserUri and JobSenderUri mandatory for FaxIn
 - n. Schema: Check that JobOriginatingUserName is still mandatory; shows optional here:
 - http://www.pwg.org/mfd/navigate/PwgSmRev1-135_PrintJobDescription.html#Link7E2
 - o. Lines 561-564 and other places like this: Maybe reword; a bit redundant and a bit more redundant
 - p. Section 8: Clarify multiple document stuff does not apply to PSTN fax
 - q. Discussion of DocumentProcessing elements:
 - The FaxInJobTicket FaxInDocumentProcessing element is applied to the job.
 - No DocumentProcessing element is attached to the document(s) that are received.
 - r. Section 8.2: Add some discussion about why ImpressionsCompleted is there, along with the element that controls whether the incoming job is printed.
 - s. Add a note concerning document-level processing instructions/overrides; not supported by the schema, edge case, etc.
 - t. Tables 4 and 5: Update.
 - u. Section 11.2: Update; "MUST implement all of the REQUIRED model objects", etc.
 - Pete: Look at FaxOut spec for same change
 - v. Section 11.2: Add MUST NOT support multiple document for PSTN.
 - w. Section 11.2.1: Update list of operations
 - x. Section 13: INTERNATIONALIZATION CONSIDERATIONS
 - y. Section 14.1: "Protection of Received FaxIn Data", SHALL -> MUST,
 - Pete: Check FaxOut spec for same change
 - z. Update list of contributors.
 - a. Update document processing elements to include everything from Print (for Fax-to-Print)
